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General Guidelines:

1. Students who are residents of Georgia in their senior year (2023 high school graduates) attending an accredited area high school with a cumulative GPA of 2.3 or above planning to attend a Technical School, Community College, University, College or Trade School are eligible for consideration.
2. Students must possess leadership qualities and some involvement in school and community service.
3. Students must submit legible hand written or computer software (Microsoft Word) applications. Students must also include:
 - An official copy of your High School transcript.
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation (at least one of the letters of recommendation should be submitted from someone outside of school).
 - A one-page paper double spaced (12-point Times New Roman Font) stating your reasons for attending the Technical School, Community College, University, College or Trade School selected.
4. A letter of recommendation for a member in good standing with "The Orient of Georgia".
5. A copy of your letter of acceptance from the Technical School, Community College, University, College or Trade School must be included with the application.
6. The Georgia Council of Deliberation Scholarship Committee will make the final scholarship selections.

The deadline for applications to be received or postmarked is October 4, 2023.

The selection process will take place during the month of November 2023 and a recommendation will be submitted to the Deputy of the Orient no later than December 30, 2023 of the potential winners. There will be three winners, one in the North, one in the South, and one in Middle Georgia. Presentation of the awards will be at the discretion of the Deputy.

5. A letter of acceptance from a Technical School, Community College, University, College or Trade School.
6. A one-page paper double spaced (12-point Times New Roman Font) stating my reasons for attending my selected Technical School, Community College, University, College or Trade School.
